Operators who are accredited are needed to run and operate articulated cranes under 16,000 lbs. capacity. The articulated crane driver should know about the various operational characteristics and features of the equipment. Before use, a pre-operational equipment check needs to be carried out. There is a legal requirement to perform a pre-operational inspection and a check of the overhead conditions and work-site ground.

The manufacturer's guidelines provide information concerning maintenance and inspection, loading and unloading of the crane. The law requires annual and daily inspections. Drivers must maintain an up-to-date logbook within nearly all regions. They may be needed to validate machine warranties.

It is suggested that companies include remote control devices to their cranes. Remote control enhances safety by allowing the driver an easier option for handling the crane.

Prioritizing crane safety helps a company's bottom line. Businesses that follow safe machine practices generally enjoy greater cost savings compared to those that don't. The risk of machine damage and personal injury is very much lessened if a well trained driver is handling the crane. Safety conscious drivers are more productive leading to reduced times required for loading and unloading.
