Aerial Lift Training Markham - The mechanized access platform known as an aerial work platform is a device that provides access to places which are otherwise inaccessible to people and other equipment. Likewise known as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is usually used to access high places. Maintenance and construction workers normally should utilize aerial work platforms on the job. They are used by firefighters for emergency access.

Meant for temporary use, aerial work platforms are distinguished from elevators, that provide permanent access to high areas. An aerial work platform is meant to be operated by one person, and can lift weights of less than one ton. Some kinds have load limits which are higher. There are various kinds of aerial work platforms; like for example, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Many of the aerial work platforms are equipped together with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist jobs, like for instance lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform could come with special equipment.

Anybody needed to operate an aerial lifting device requires training, along with their superiors. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial machine work places likewise need to go through training. Trainees would become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They would likewise learn the regulations that apply to safely using these machinery. Rules differ in different provinces, and within federally regulated worksites.

Employees who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting machinery should know all the potential dangers. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown in order to educate all of the employees who are lifted by them or work near them.

Aerial Lift Training Program comprises modules focused on the following: Hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The program is designed to train employees on the safe operation of self-propelled, elevated work platforms and boom supported, self-propelled, elevated work platforms. Employees who complete the program would be given a certificate, signed by someone qualified to be able to verify the successful completion of a hands-on practical evaluation.
